Information about EBOLA Virus Disease

An outbreak of EBOLA virus disease is ongoing in some parts of the world. These are Guinea, Sierra Leone, Liberia, Lagos and Nigeria.

You are considered in the risk group regarding EBOLA disease if you have been to one of these countries and in addition to this if you have been in contact with an infected person or if you have consumed a wild animal or have been in contact with such animals or if you have had unprotected sexual contact.

If have been in one of the countries of risk and you have been exposed to risks stated above and in addition to this if you have high fever please bring this to the attention of a flight attendant in order to enable us to help you.

If you have been in one of the countries of risk you need to measure your body temperature for 21 days from your armpit. In the event that it exceeds 37 degrees centigrade and/or if you experience one of the following symptoms you can reach us for free through the numbers stated below and can receive free health care: muscle pain, fatigue, headache, sour throat, stomachache, diarrhoea, vomiting, bleeding from / reddening of the eyes.
